- Q. What is your name and age?
A. My name is Lucy Lottson-Lewis and I am 37 years of age.
- Q. What relation were you to Robert Lottson?
A. He was my husband?
- Q. When were you and Robert Lottson married?
A. In the spring of 1893.
- Q. Were you married by custom or by ceremony?
A. By Indian Custom.
- Q. About when did Robert Lottson die?
A. June 24, 1907.
- Q. At the time of his death were you and Robert Lottson living together as man and wife?
A. Yes.
- Q. Were there any children born to you and Robert Lottson?
A. Yes. Six, but they are all dead.
- Q. What are their names and dates ~~and~~ of death and birth?
A. An infant who died at birth, a daughter, born in 1894.
Louis Lottson, born August 15, 1896, died July 1, 1903.
Alfred Lottson, born May 25, 1903, died in July 1903.
Aaron Lottson, born May 25, 1903, died in July, 1903, about a week after Alfred, his twin brother.
William Lottson, born in September, 1904, died the same month
Ran Lottson, born November 6, 1906, died November 7, 1906.
- Q. Where was Robert Lottson living when he died?
A. We were living in the Osage Indian Nation.
- Q. Was Robert Lottson ever married to any other woman?
A. No.
- Q. Are the above named children all the children of Robert Lottson?
A. Yes sir.
