In the matter of the heirship cases of Mary J. Calf, deceased Quapaw allottee No. 90 and Buffalo Calf, deceased Quapaw allottee No. 89 and Thomas Buffalo deceased Quapaw allottee No. 92 comes now Louis Angell or Tall Chief, who being of legal age and first being duly sworn answers the following questions under oath:

- Q. What is your name and age?
A. My name is Louis Angell or Tall Chief and I am 68 years of age.
- Q. Were you acquainted with Buffalo Calf and his family history?
A. Yes.
- Q. About when did Buffalo Calf die?
A. He died about 11 years ago.
- Q. At the time of his death was he married or single?
A. He was married.
- Q. What was the name of his wife?
A. Her Indian name was Mah-ski.
- Q. Is Mah-ski, or Mary J. Calf living or dead?
A. She is dead.
- Q. About when did she die?
A. About three years ago.
- Q. Was she single or married at the time of her death?
A. She was single.
- Q. Did Buffalo Calf have any children by Mah-ski, or Mary J. Calf?
A. Yes.
- Q. What were their names?
A. The oldest was Ho-gah-nah-she, or Frank Buffalo, the next was An-no-mon-e or Thomas Buffalo, these were all the children.
- Q. Did Buffalo have any children by any other woman?
A. His eldest child was the son of his first wife, ~~Kah-dah-skah~~ Kah-dah-skah, his name was Ga-dah-skah, or Joe Buffalo.
- Q. Were these all the children of Buffalo Calf?
A. Yes.
- Q. Were Buffalo Calf and Kah-dah-skah, married by custom or by ceremony?
A. They were married by custom.

- Q. Is Kah-dah-skah the first wife of Buffalo calf living or dead, if dead about how long has she been dead?
- A. Her son Joe was a small boy when she died.
- Q. Did Kah-dah-skah, the first wife of Buffalo calf die before he lived with his last wife, Mary J. Calf?
- A. He was married to Mary J. Calf after his first wife died.
- Q. Were Buffalo Calf and Mary J. Calf married under custom or by ceremony.
- A. They were married by custom.
- Q. Is Joe Buffalo, the other son of Buffalo Calf, living or dead?
- A. He is dead.
- Q. About when did he die?
- A. About six or seven years ago.
- Q. At the time of his death was he married or single?
- A. He was married.
- Q. What was his wife's name and is she living or dead?
- A. Her name was Sinnie Brown, and she is dead.
- Q. About when did she die?
- A. About two years ago.
- Q. Was Joe Buffalo ever married prior to his marriage to Sinnie Brown?
- A. Yes. He was married to Ollie Medicine. She is dead.
- Q. Was Sinnie Brown-Buffalo married or single when she died?
- A. She was single.
- Q. Was Ollie Medicine-Buffalo married or single when she died?
- A. She was married.
- Q. What was her husband's name?
- A. John Wilson.
- Q. Is John Wilson dead or alive, if dead about when did he die?
- A. John Wilson and his wife, Ollie, were coming from the Osage Country in a covered wagon and were killed by a Railroad train running into their wagon near Bluejacket, Indian Territory, now Oklahoma.
- A. About how long ago was it since John Wilson and Ollie were killed by the railroad train?
- A. About 11 years ago.

- Q. Was Joe Buffalo and Ollie Medicine separated before either of them died?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. How were Joe Buffalo and Ollie Medicine married?
- A. They were married by custom.
- Q. How were they separated?
- A. They just left each other under Indian custom.
- Q. Were there any children born to Ollie Medicine by Joe Buffalo?
- A. There was one child born to Ollie by Joe Buffalo. His name is Arthur Buffalo, living.
- Q. Was Ollie Medicine married to any other man except Joe Buffalo and John Wilson?
- A. No.
- Q. Did Ollie have any children by John Wilson?
- A. No.
- Q. Did Joe Buffalo have any children by his last wife, Sinnie Brown?
- A. Yes.
- Q. How many and what are their names?
- A. Yes, he had five children but I do not know their names.
- Q. Are these five children living?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Is Thomas Buffalo, the son of Buffalo calf and Mary J. calf, living or dead?
- A. He is dead.
- Q. About when did he die? and was he single or married at the time of his death?
- A. He died a number of years ago and was single when he died.
- Q. Is Frank Buffalo, the son of Buffalo calf and Mary J. calf living or dead?
- A. He is dead.
- Q. About when did he die and was he single or married when he died?
- A. He died a number of years ago, before Thomas did, and was married.
- Q. Who was his wife and is she living?
- A. Her name was Alice Brown and she is dead.

- Q. Did Frank Buffalo have any children by Alice Brown?
A. Yes.
- Q. How many and what were there names?
A. Yes. He had two. John Buffalo, living, and the other one died in infancy.
- Q. Did this infant die before or after its mother?
A. Before its mother.
- Q. About when did Alice Brown, the wife of Frank Buffalo, die?
A. She died a good many years ago.
- Q. Which died first, Frank Buffalo, or his wife, Alice?
A. Frank died first.
- Q. Did Frank Buffalo have any children by any other woman?
A. No.
- Q. Did Alice Brown have any children by any other man except Frank Buffalo?
A. At the time of her death she was living with Alex Beaver, but I do not know whether she had any children by him.
- Q. At the time of Alice Brown's death was she living with Alex Beaver?
A. She was living with him.
- Q. Were Alice Brown-Buffalo and Alex Beaver married?
A. They were married by ceremony.
- Q. Where was Alice Brown-Buffalo and Alex Beaver married?
A. They were married at Miami.
- Q. Is Alex Beaver living or dead?
A. He is living.
- Q. Did Frank Buffalo die before or after his father, Buffalo Calf?
A. Buffalo Calf died first.
- Q. Did Thomas Buffalo die before or after his father Buffalo Calf?
A. I do not know.
