- A. The girl was the second child?
- Q. What are the names of the boys?
- A. The eldest name is She-wah, or Amos Vallier. The other is He-a-gah-dah-tun-kah, or George Vallier.
- Q. Are Amos Vallier and George Vallier living or dead?
- A. They are both dead.
- Q. About when did Amos Vallier die?
- A. Not many years ago.
- Q. At the time of his death was he married or single?
- A. He was married.

- Q. What was the name of his wife and is she living?
A. I do not know her name, but she is a white woman and I believe she is still living.
- Q. Did Amos Vallier have any children?
A. I heard that they had two children.
- Q. Do you know whether they are living?
A. I do not know.
- Q. Was Amos Vallier ever married prior to his marriage to this white woman?
A. Yes.
- Q. To whom was he married?
A. He was married to a Peoria Indian, I do not know her English name?
- Q. Did Amos Vallier have any children by this Peoria woman?
A. No.
- Q. To the best of your knowledge ^{and belief} / did Amos Vallier have any other children except by his last wife?
A. No.
- Q. About when did George Vallier die?
A. I do not know when he died but it has been a good many years ago.
- Q. At the time of his death was he single or married?
A. He was married.
- Q. What was the name of his wife and is she living?
A. I do not know her name but she is a white woman.
- Q. Is she living?
A. Yes, I think she is.
- Q. Did George Vallier have any children by this white woman?
A. Yes.
- Q. How many and what are their names?
A. The last time I saw him he had three children but I do not know their names.
- Q. Did Alice Brown-Buffalo have any children by Alex Peavery?
A. Yes. She had one child by Alex.
